- What do you need to find out?



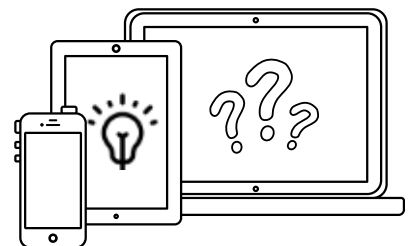
GUIDING QUESTION

Record notes from your research.

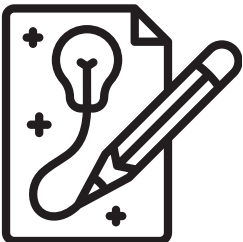
- Where will you find reliable information to answer the driving question?

Map out some ideas for your presentation.

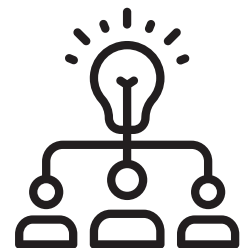
- How will you organise your information and ideas in order to effectively share what you discover with others?



CREATE

Consider writing a task list and allocating different roles to members of your group.

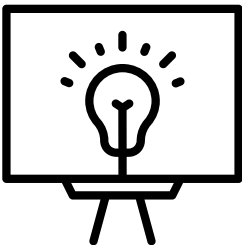
- What resources will you need to create your design?

PRESENT / DISCUSS

- How do their results connect with what you are studying?



REFLECT

- What were some of the successes of your inquiry?
- What would you do differently next time?
